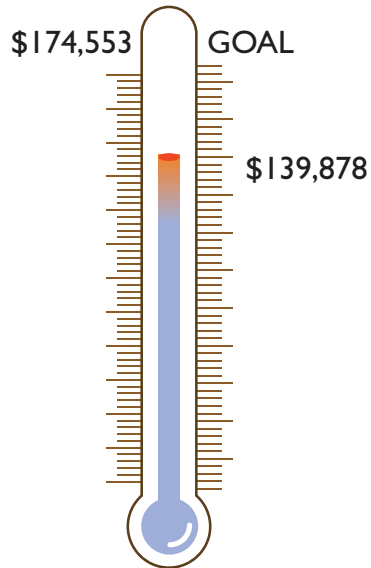
**LSCC Mortgage Goal Update**
