- have a healthy grasp of the Bible and Christian doctrine (no need to be a Bible scholar or expert)
- have a humble, teachable spirit
- be interested in people and meeting their needs
- be able to provide basic organization (take attendance, answer e-mails, etc.)

A home group leader is not required to serve as the host each week. Every home group decides where to meet. They may choose one home to host them every week, or rotate meeting at various homes.
